TIPS FOR WRITING YOUR PROPOSAL

Small business grants are highly competitive. To improve your chances, ensure your application is complete, clearly outlines how the funds will be used, demonstrates business viability, and aligns with the grant's goals and criteria.

GATHER REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Conversely, a small retailer failed to win a local economic development grant due to incomplete documentation and vague financial projections. These examples underscore that thorough preparation and adherence to guidelines are vital.
