Public transportation options are limited, so renting a vehicle is recommended for maximum flexibility.

Photography restrictions, respectful conduct during cultural performances, and adherence to park regulations are essential for a positive experience. The guide advises consulting official tribal websites and visitor centers for up-to-date information.
