## Parallel Structure

Lists or comparisons should follow the same grammatical format.

- Correct: I like \*\*running, swimming, and biking\*\*.
- Incorrect: I like \*\*running, swimming, and to bike\*\*.

## Punctuation Essentials for SAT Writing
